

TOWN OF JEFFERSON  
BOARD OF SELECTMEN  
January 11, 2016

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday January 11, 2016 at 5:00 pm

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, and Tom Brady, members comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen;

Kevin Meehan opened the regular meeting at 5:10 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week. The Highway and Transfer Station report was reviewed. The warrants were signed. Terri Larcomb was in to pickup signed warrants and sign checks.

Tom Brady made a motion to accept the January 4, 2016 minutes of the Selectmen Meeting as presented. Kevin seconded the motion, the motion carries.

Tom reported that the Selectmen will be given a private tour of the Jefferson School with Superintendent Anastasia and the Director of Building and Grounds, therefore no one attended the tour held on January 7<sup>th</sup>.

Linda Cushman reported that Donald Saucier was in to inquire why he had not been notified of the snowmachine club using the Chambers Road. He was told that nothing had changed since the club was given permission to use the road several years ago and he had been notified then. The reason that the club was given permission to use the road was because Mr. Saucier did not want them on his property any more.

The abatement for the Cook land use penalty was signed.

Linda reported that in 1994 a warrant article was presented to the voters authorizing the Selectmen to dispose of tax deeded property by public or private sale. The article passed.

Kevin said that he would like a certified copy sent to Mr. Matson. This should answer his question as to whether the Selectmen sold tax deeded property properly. A letter will be prepared for the Boards signatures.

Linda was asked to draft a letter to the WMRSD informing the District that the Selectmen feel that the Jefferson School represents the spirit of the Town and the Selectmen believe the school should continue to operate. The rumors of closing the school does nothing but keep residents in a turmoil, if at some time the District decide to go ahead and close the School the Town would like the opportunity to take the building back.

February 1, 2016 Josephine Belville of DRA will be in to meet with the Selectmen to review the 2016 property revaluation procedures. She will also introduce the new area inspector.

The budget hearing will be held February 8, 2016 at 7:00 pm.

The next meeting will be January 25, 2016, at 6:30 pm.

Tom made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Kevin seconded the motion, motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 5:50 pm.
