

TOWN OF JEFFERSON
BOARD OF SELECTMEN

January 13, 2014

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday January 13 2014 at 3:30 pm.

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, Chairman and Tom Brady members comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen.

Kevin Meehan opened the regular meeting at 3:40 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway and Transfer Station report was reviewed.

The Selectmen signed the North Country Mutual Aid District agreement for the 2014 year.

Tom Brady made a motion to accept the minutes of the January 6, 2014 Selectmen meeting as presented. Kevin seconded the motion. Motion carries.

Linda said that she had calculated the cost of the note for the bridge replacement. Payments of approximately \$20,000 plus interest would be about thirteen cents per thousand. However where the Town has been making a payment of \$20,000 plus each year for the last ten years this article would not increase the tax rate.

In making a review of the purposed budget it was determined that the highway budget should be increased to \$135,000. With the increased fuel cost and cost of winter sand the increase is warranted.

The State election will be held Tuesday January 21, 2014, polls will be open from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm.

The next Selectmen meeting will be January 20, 2014 at 7:00 pm.

Tom made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Kevin seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 4:15 pm.
