BOARD OF SELECTMEN

January 19, 2015

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday January 19, 2015 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Thomas Brady, Chairman, and Kevin Meehan members comprising a quorum of the Board.

Thomas Brady opened the regular meeting at 7:00 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week. The Highway and Transfer Station report was reviewed. The warrants were signed. The Treasurer was in to sign checks.

Kevin Meehan made a motion to accept the minutes of the January 12, 2015 Selectmen minutes as written. Tom Brady seconded the motion. Motion carries.

Mike Hatfield brought in two intents to cut for Roger Daigle and Roger Daigle II. The Selectmen signed the intents.

Mike also presented a pistol permit for himself to be approved. The application was taken and will be forwarded to Officer Desrochers.

Jeff Wiseman was in to inform the Board that he has been in contact with Paul Ingersoll regarding the EMD position. Mr. Ingersoll has shown some interest in the position, Jeff said that he will speak again with him.

Jeff asked what he should do with all the materials that he has. It was suggested that all the paperwork be stored in the fire department office and the radio be left at the town office.

Jeff said that there will be a meeting in Randolph on writing a policy for pipeline safety on Wednesday the 21<sup>st</sup>. He will attend the meeting.

A request from Bruce Johnson of Webster has asked if the Town would include a warrant article requesting the State to provide a comprehensive system of funding education. It is the decision of the Selectmen not to include the article.

Kevin made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Tom seconded the motion. The motion carries.
