January 20, 2014

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday January 20 2014 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, Chairman and Tom Brady members comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen, Terri Larcomb.

Kevin Meehan opened the regular meeting at 7:05 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway and Transfer Station report was reviewed. Terri Larcomb was in to pick up signed warrants and sign checks.

Tom Brady made a motion to accept the minutes of the January 13, 2014 Selectmen meeting as presented. Kevin seconded the motion. Motion carries.

Tom asked if PILT payments had been included in the budget. Linda said yes, however, only about half the amount that had been received in 2013. It is unsure if the 100% funding will continue it was part of the stimulus package that was to have only be through 2012. Tom stated that the PILT payments are being tied to the "farm bill".

The next Selectmen meeting will be January 27, 2014 at 7:00 pm.

Tom made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Kevin seconded the motion. The motion carries.

The Selectmen set up the hall for the election on Tuesday.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 7:30 pm.
