SELECT BOARD
March 12, 2018

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday March 12, 2018 at 7:00 pm

PRESENT: Tom Brady, Chair; Cindy Silver and Kevin Meehan(7:08), members comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen; Terri Larcomb, Treasurer; Lynne Holland, Moderator; Mark Dubois, Highway Foreman

Tom Brady opened the regular Select Board meeting at 7:00 pm. The Highway and Transfer Station report was reviewed. The Treasurer was in to sign checks and pickup signed warrants.

Cindy Silver made a motion to accept the minutes of the March 5, 2018 Select Board meeting as presented. Kevin Meehan seconded the motion. The motion carries.

The accounts payable and payroll warrants were signed.

Bills were approved for payment March 19, 2018.

Lynne Holland, Moderator was in to inform the Board that elections would go on as scheduled per the latest from the Secretary of State. She has checked with the DOT, Fire Chief and Police and they assured her that they were prepared for the approaching storm. This storm is not expected to be as bad as last years.

Lynne said that she is going to request a written ballot for the article regarding selling water to the Old Corner Store. This way no one will feel pressured by the way they vote.

Mark Dubois reported that the roads are holding up. They are rough but not muddy.

They made some more repairs to the Int'l. It seems to be running better now than it has in years. It does the burn off as it is supposed to.

Mark said that he would make sure the Odd Fellows Hall is plowed for the Town Meeting supper.

Linda Cushman reported that the cost of upgrading the Quickbook Pro is \$219.95. The Board approved the purchase of the upgrade. The current version of QB will no longer be serviced after May 1, 2018. Linda will order.

Cindy said that her mother, a member of the Christmas Festival would like to put a wishing well around the well head on the front lawn at the Town Office. Also they would like to include a bench so people could stop and sit if they wanted.

The Board approved the request, stating that it should look good and a bench would be nice.

Cindy made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Kevin seconded the motion. Motion carries.
