BOARD OF SELECTMEN
March 17, 2014

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday March 17, 2014 at 7:10 pm.

PRESENT: Thomas Brady, Chairman and Kevin Meehan members comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen,

Thomas Brady opened the regular meeting at 7:10 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway and Transfer Station report was reviewed. Terri Larcomb will be in Tuesday pick up the signed warrants and sign checks.
