BOARD OF SELECTMEN  
April 21, 2014

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday April 21, 2014 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Thomas Brady, Chairman and Kevin Meehan members comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen

Thomas Brady opened the regular meeting at 7:10 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway and Transfer Station report was reviewed. The warrants were signed and will approved for payment.

Kevin Meehan made a motion to accept the minutes of the April 14, 2014 Selectmen meeting as presented. Tom seconded the motion. Motion carries.

Randall Northrop of Corrette & Associates will be in on the 28<sup>th</sup> to go over the procedures for the 2013 audit with the Selectmen.

Larry from the Waumbek Golf Course has asked if the Town would give a letter stating that the Town does not have an issue with serving alcohol on the deck at the Club House and from the service cart. Larry said that Mr. Friel is making a few changes and the State needs to know the Towns position. The Selectmen said that it would not be an issue for the Waumbek to serve alcohol on the Club House deck and from the service cart as long as State liquor laws are being followed. Linda Cushman was asked to write a letter stating the Selectmen position.

Tom said that he had not had a chance to review the letter from CAI regarding the change in billing practices. Tom asked Linda to call to find out how the billing would be handled if there wasn't any map updates.

Linda had been in contact with the attorney regarding the James Lewis property. There is no way that an inspection of the building can be made without giving prior notice. The Town should not be questioning the use of the property unless proper documentation can be provided.

Mr. Lewis has not been able to get a driveway permit from the State yet. Attorney Riff says they are continuing to work on it.

Kevin made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Tom seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 7:40 pm.
