

TOWN OF JEFFERSON
BOARD OF SELECTMEN
May 12, 2014

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday May 12, 2014 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Thomas Brady, Chairman and Kevin Meehan members comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen

Thomas Brady opened the regular meeting at 7:04 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway and Transfer Station report was reviewed. The warrants were signed and will approved for payment.

Kevin Meehan made a motion to accept the minutes of the May 5, 2014 Selectmen meeting as presented. Tom seconded the motion. Motion carries.

Tom said that Jennifer Fish, the County Administrator will be getting a letter to all towns in the County giving them notice of the utility defense fund.

Ms. Fish will also be getting a copy of the Coös Economic Impact Study of Current and Proposed Federal Land ownership in Coös County. This report will be made available in an electronic file as well. Tom said that the County Commissioners plan to meet with the woman who did the study to go over it so they have a full understanding of the study. This meeting will be in the evening so as many people can attend as wants to. The Federal government continues to cut payments on these federal lands.

Linda reported that she had checked at Atlantic Leasing regarding the replacement of the doors on the trash containers. They estimated between \$900 and \$1000 to build new doors. Mark Dubois had estimated \$1200 to build new doors. Tom said to ask Mark if he would have the time to build the doors.

Tom said that the County Delegation voted to increase the Sheriff and County Attorney salaries by \$6000, the Treasurer by \$1000 and the Commissioners salaries by \$1000.

The contract for ambulance service from Lancaster was reviewed. Tom suggested not to sign it until next week when the full Board would be here.

Kevin made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Tom seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 7:30 pm.
