BOARD OF SELECTMEN  
July 11, 2016

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday July 11, 2016 at 6:30 pm

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, Chair; and Tom Brady, members comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen

Kevin Meehan opened the regular meeting at 6:50 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week. The Highway and Transfer Station report was reviewed. The warrants were signed. Terri Larcomb was in to pickup signed warrants and sign checks.

Cindy Silver made a motion to accept the minutes of the June 27, 2016 Selectmen Meeting as written. Tom Brady seconded the motion. Motion carries. (correction Tom Brady made motion Kevin Meehan seconded the motion)

A proposal from TAC-2 for a new base radio was approved in the amount of \$467.00. The current base is outdated as it is a backup for the Fire Department it was recommended to do the upgrade.

The abatements for Frederick Lovejoy and Northern NH Nursery were reviewed. The abatement for the Lovejoy property was to reduce the land value on parcel 37 due to the topography and access and to reduce the building quality and condition to average. The Northern NH Nursery reduced the land value to for the access. Both abatements were approved.

Andy French, Project Leader for the Silvio O. Conte National Fish and Wildlife Refuge was in last week. He had mentioned that there is a Federal Land Access Program (FLAP) that may be available to improve the access to Refuge access points. He forwarded a copy of an application from another project for review to see if the Town may be able to use the FLAP to improve access from the Hazen Road. The Board agreed that this program is something to look into more.

Pistol permits were signed for George Bishop, Chris Chasseur, and Donald Crocker.

Kevin said that reports from the 4<sup>th</sup> of July celebration were all good. The fireworks were well attended and better than last year. The first home run derby and cookout were well attended. Linda said that someone had mentioned that the home run derby and cookout if done another year might get more attendance if a sign was put up in the parking area so people knew what was going on.

Edith Tucker had dropped off copies of the Strategic Planning Committee report for the Board.

The next meeting will be held Monday July 18, 2016 6:30 pm.

Tom made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Kevin seconded the motion, motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 7:10 pm.
