

TOWN OF JEFFERSON  
SELECT BOARD  
July 31, 2017

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday, July 31 2017 at 7:00 pm

PRESENT: Cindy Silver and Kevin Meehan members comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen; Mark Dubois, Road Foreman

Cindy Silver opened the regular meeting at 7:08 pm. The Highway and Transfer Station report was reviewed.

Kevin Meehan made a motion to accept the minutes of the July 24, 2017 Select Board meeting as written. Cindy Silver seconded the motion. Motion carries.

Kevin stated the Chairman Brady would not be in as he had hurt his back.

The accounts payable and payroll warrants were signed.

The invoices were reviewed and approved for payment August 7, 2017.

A yield tax bill and warrant was signed in the amount of \$1959.79.

The quotes for the drilling of the well at the Town Garage were reviewed. Capital Well is for \$9878 drilling 400 feet, Town to provide electrical from the disconnect box; Carr Well is for \$10,051 drilling 300 feet and providing electrical. The price per foot is the same, the cost of hiring an electrician could offset the price difference. Each quote has some minor differences.

Kevin made a motion to accept the quote from Carr Well. Cindy seconded the motion. Motion carries.

Mark Dubois reported that they have been working on the Turnpike Road and should have it done by the end of the week along with the Whipple Road. Jason Ave., Abigail Circle and Crystal Ave have been graded.

There needs to be a couple loads of gravel put on Hyfield Lane. The ditching is done there.

Mark said that more chloride will need to be ordered. There is only 4 bags left. One bag is used per two-miles of road. Linda was asked to order a load of chloride.

Cindy asked Mark to talk with Diane at the Waumbek regarding the road that is used when the fireworks are setup. There is apparently a bad dip that causes an issue when the vehicle that is doing the setup tries to get through.

Kevin asked Mark about doing the ditch on the easterly side of the west entrance onto the Ingerson Road. Mark said that he was waiting for the new machine to come in so that they would be able to clean the ditch and sweep the pavement after the work is completed.

Linda presented a quote from Carr Well for a carbon pleated filter system to be added to the water system. There is sulfur in the water supply causing an odor. The Board approved the installation of the filtration system in the amount of \$470.68.

GoSolar had requested that the Board approve the use of the Town's name supporting GoSolar in their letter advertising a meeting to residents promoting solar power. The Board approved the request. A meeting is scheduled for September 7<sup>th</sup> 6 to 8 pm.

The Board reviewed the changes to the website. The new calendars have been added and the departments changed and added. There was a request to add the chamber of commerce to the link page and remove the businesses that are on the business page. Linda was asked to find out if there was a problem with the calendar as it does not seem to work on an Iphone.

Linda said that someone had asked about the town government facebook page. The Town does not have a facebook page. There is a jefferson nh facebook page but it is not a Town page. The Board will look into this.

The next meeting will be August 7, 2017 at 7:00 pm

Kevin made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Cindy seconded the motion. Motion carries.

The meeting adjourned at 8:20 pm.
