

TOWN OF JEFFERSON
BOARD OF SELECTMEN
August 29, 2016

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday August 29, 2016 at 6: 30 pm

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, Chair, and Tom Brady members comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen; Mark Dubois, Highway Foreman; Mike Hatfield

Kevin Meehan opened the regular meeting at 6:50 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week. The Highway and Transfer Station report was reviewed. The warrants were signed. Terri Larcomb was in to pickup signed warrants and sign checks.

Tom Brady made a motion to accept the minutes of the August 22, 2016 Selectboard meeting. Kevin seconded the motion. Motion carries.

Mark Dubois reported that he had gotten pricing for winter sand. Carroll Concrete price is \$9.50 per ton and Pike Industries is \$10.63 per ton. Both prices include delivery. The Board approved the purchase of winter sand from Carroll Concrete at \$9.50 per ton. Mark said that he would order 1500 tons.

Mark said that he would like to have the west and east end of the Whipple Road paved if the funds are available. The cost for the east end would be \$9,300 and the west end \$5,250. There is enough funds available to do one section. The budget will have to be reviewed to see if there is any additional funds available there. Mark said that the east end is the most important to get done this year. Linda was asked to review the budget to see where the budget stands and report back next week.

The MS-535 financial report was signed to be submitted to DRA.

The Board was reminded that the primary election would be September 13, 2016.

The Board reviewed the purposed assessment values. There were several question regarding some of the changes in the land values. Linda was asked to clarify this with John Trumbull.

A pistol permit was signed for Tom Armstrong and a duplicate permit was issued for Mike Hatfiled.

The next meeting will be held Tuesday September 6, 2016 6:30 pm.

Tom made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Kevin seconded the motion, motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm.
