BOARD OF SELECTMEN
September 30, 2013

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday September 30, 2013 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, Chairman and Tom Brady and Norman Brown members comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen;

Kevin Meehan opened the regular meeting at 7:10 The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway Department report was reviewed. The warrants were signed.

Norman Brown made a motion to approve the minutes of the September 23, 2013 Selectman's meeting as written. Tom Brady seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Kevin reported on the site visit of the Lewis property that the Planning Board had. Mr. Lewis was not in attendance, however his sister was there. There seems to be some confusion with the Lewis' as to why the Town is concerned with the access. The Planning Board will be meeting on October 8 to continue the Lewis hearing that started September 24.

Norman reported that he had heard from Bruce Mailman of Coleman and they will donate the remainder of the concrete needed to do the retaining wall at the Honor Roll. Ken Bronson has estimated the form work would be \$1400. Norman thought that it would be possible to get funds to cover this cost. Norman said that he is in hopes to have pictures and a 3-D display ready for Town Meeting in March.

The next Selectman's meetings will be October 7 and October 21.

Tom made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Norman seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 7:45 pm.
