

TOWN OF JEFFERSON
BOARD OF SELECTMEN

December 1, 2014

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday December 1, 2014 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Thomas Brady, Chairman, and Kevin Meehan members comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen

Thomas Brady opened the regular meeting at 7:07 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway and Transfer Station report was reviewed. The warrants were signed and bills approved for payment.

Kevin Meehan made a motion to accept the minutes of the November 24, 2014 Selectmen minutes as written. Tom Brady seconded the motion. Motion carries.

The Board went over the preliminary budget for 2015. An increase of \$1000 to the executive account and government building & grounds accounts to cover salary expense, financial admin an increase of \$2000 to cover salaries and overall expenses, as well as the insurance account will see an increase of \$3000 due to the fact that the credit from the workers comp is less than it was in 2014. The patriotic budget will be increase by \$1000. The patriotic budget covers the fireworks.

The fire department budget will be decreased by \$5000, the Fire Chief has said that the major vehicle repairs have been made(his recommendation).

The figures for the library will not be ready until 12/8.

Mark Dubois said that the salesman for the liquid chloride has not gotten the figures together yet. He is in hopes to have something this week.

The CRF were reviewed. The Selectmen would like to continue the deposits to these accounts as previous and include deposits to the dump closure and Rt 115B reconstruction in the amount of \$2000 each. The highway maintenance CRF would be reduced to \$5000.

Linda was asked to check into the purchase of a container for the Transfer Station and chairs for the Town Hall.

The next meeting will be December 8, 2014.

Kevin made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Tom seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm.
