

TOWN OF JEFFERSON
BOARD OF SELECTMEN
December 21, 2015

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday December 21, 2015 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, and Tom Brady, members comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen;

Kevin Meehan opened the regular meeting at 7:10 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week. The Highway and Transfer Station report was reviewed. The warrants were signed. Terri Larcomb was in to pickup signed warrants and sign checks.

Tom Brady made a motion to accept the December 14, 2015 minutes of the Selectmen Meeting as presented. Kevin seconded the motion, the motion carries.

The Board reviewed the 12/7/15 letter from Whitefield Board of Selectmen proposing a 25% Jefferson and 75% Whitefield split regarding the refurbishing of the Airport/Hazen Road. The Selectmen agreed that the split was fair, however they believe that the road needs to be brought up to standard from the neglected state it is currently. A letter will be prepared.

Tom reported that the DES online sub-surface program that has been implemented is not working as designed. He suggest that DES needs to be contacted to let them know of the issues.

Kevin reported that there were a number of people at the School Board meeting to let the School Board know that they did not favor the elimination of the wrestling program. Kevin said that he had to leave before the Board made any decision.
