

TOWN OF JEFFERSON  
BOARD OF SELECTMEN

March 25, 2013

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday March 25, 2013 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, Chairman and Tom Brady member comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen

Kevin Meehan opened the regular meeting at 7:10. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway Department report was reviewed.

Tom Brady made a motion to accept the minutes of the March 11, 2013 meeting as Written. Kevin seconded the motion. Motion carries.

Kevin stated that he had no desire to revisit the ballot clerk salary as passed at the March 18, 2013 meeting. No action was taken on the issue.

Kevin stated that he had checked on getting the topo maps. It was going to require the purchase of five different maps and they were not current dating 1985 and 1992. Tom said that he thought that he would see Micaela Purcell of Amusement Media Tuesday and would try to get the map issue resolved.

The MS-2 showing the approved expenses for the Department of Revenue was signed.

The Department of Transportation annual map update and State Aid questionnaire was reviewed. There were no boundary changes or new road acceptances. There were three corrections to street names as displayed on the map. Kevin signed the map change request.

Tom suggested that a sympathy card be sent to the Harold Burns' family. Mr. Burns had served the North Country for many years in the House of Representatives.

It was suggested that the Selectmen meeting agenda be posted on the web site prior to the meetings.

Linda reported that Thursday March 21, 2013 Carolyn Ingerson had fallen when leaving the Library. It was reported that when Ms. Ingerson stepped into the highway she slipped. Linda said that she filed an accident report with LGC.

There was some discussion as to what might be done to help the issue of entrance to the Library. In the spring when work can be done it was suggested to see if the Highway Department would be able to dig out some of the walkway to allow for a landing before entering the highway.

The Selectmen discussed the closure of buildings during inclement weather. When the weather conditions are dangerous as they were last Tuesday(3/19/13) poor traveling and visibility public buildings should be closed.

The next meeting will be April 1, 2013, a safety meeting will be the first item on the agenda. Kevin said that he may be a few minutes late.

Tom made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded and carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm.
