

TOWN OF JEFFERSON
BOARD OF SELECTMEN

April 8, 2013

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday April 8, 2013 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, Chairman and Tom Brady member comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen; Terri Larcomb, Treasurer

Kevin Meehan opened the regular meeting at 7:40. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway Department report was reviewed. Terri Larcomb was in to sign checks and pickup signed warrants.

The Selectmen viewed the Town Hall and determined that the party that had rented the hall over the weekend needed to either clean the hall or the deposit check would not be returned.

In discussing the use of the Town Hall the Selectmen believe that it is not in the best interest of the Town to allow alcoholic beverages on the premises. This should apply to all future functions.

A building permit for Richard Clark was approved to construct a storage building.

The EMPG Grant agreement was approved and signed. The grant is for a portable radio for the Police Department. The Grant is a 50/50 grant the Town share would be \$1,278.00. The completion date would be May 31, 2014.

Tom made a motion to accept the minutes of the April 1, 2013 Selectmen Meeting minutes as written. Kevin seconded the motion. Motion carries.

Steve Noyes has stated that he would like to continue mowing the Kilkenny Cemetery, however his mower needs to be replaced and he prefers not to replace it. He is asking if it would be possible to us the Town mower and work on his hourly rate. Steve estimates that it would take five hours to do the mowing. To do the mowing as a contractor Steve was getting \$135.00 for each mowing. Kevin estimated that it would be approximately a \$1000 savings to the Town after figuring for fuel and wear on the machine. The Selectmen approved Steve Noyes mowing the Kilkenny Cemetery at his hour rate as an employee using the Town mower.

The review of the elderly exemption applications was held over for review at the next meeting.

The Library Committee rescheduled to the March 15 meeting.

Tom made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded and carries. Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:00 pm.
