

**BOARD OF SELECTMEN
TOWN OF JEFFERSON
January 11, 2010**

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen's Office Monday, January 11, 2010 at 7:00 p.m.

PRESENT: Norman Brown, Chairman(7:10), and Kevin Meehan, and Bruce Hicks members comprising a quorum of the Board.

PRESENT: Paul Couture, Road Agent, Larry Wells, Lucile Guild and Carl Lindquist

Kevin Meehan opened the meeting at 7:04 p.m. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway report was reviewed. Larry Wells took the warrants and checks to deliver to the Wendy Wells.

Bruce Hicks made a motion to accept the minutes of the January 4, 2010 Selectmen minutes. Kevin seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Paul Couture reported that they had trimmed some trees on the Ingerson Road. If the weather permits they will continue the work.

The purchase of a spare drive chain for the sander was approved.

Lucile Guild and Care Lindquist for Ammonoosuc Region Habitat for Humanity presented information about their program and left information for distribution.

Norman Brown had gotten prices for grader tires. Michelin's XTLA radials at a cost of \$1279 each (7674) and \$1000 mounting for 6 tires, bias ply BKT \$506 each (3036) and \$1000 to mount.

The Davenport School has asked that the Road Agent call 1-hour prior to plowing so that, cars can be moved.

George Giles of US Census has requested to use the Town Hall for 9 days of training. It is the decision of the Board that it would more feasible for the group contacted the NH Fish & Game in Lancaster to use their building. If there was any conflicts the Town Hall could be used.

The Board discussed doing an addition for the Town Office. It was their decision to put this off for another year.

Norman said that he would like to attend the LGC training on January 26.

Two building permits were approved for Santa's Village. Pistol permits were signed for John Bishop and Fred Ingerson, II.

The current use application from Peter Nehring was determined to be incomplete. Linda Cushman will be asked to contact Mr. Nehring to make the corrections.

The Board voted to include a page in the Town Report honoring Ed Ashby.

The revised map provided by Time Warner Cable was reviewed. As the Board was not able to completely understand the legends it was determined the government Time Warner representative should be invited to meet with the Board to identify future expansion.

The revised budget with estimated revenues was reviewed. The final revenue figures will be looked at the next meeting.

Bruce made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Kevin seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
