The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday, February 28, 2011 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan and Norman Brown members comprising a quorum of the Board.

Kevin Meehan opened the meeting at 7:00 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway report was reviewed. The Treasurer was in to sign checks and pick up signed warrants.

Norman Brown made a motion to approve the minute of the February 21, 2011 minutes as written. The motion was seconded and carries.

An intent to cut for George Murray was signed.

North Country Council has submitted a resolution that they adopted on 2/23/2011 regarding the Northern Pass Project. They would like any input that the Selectmen may have. It was decided that nothing would be done until after Town Meeting to see how the voters want to be represented.

AVRRDD is having a DES training for employees at Mt. Carberry Landfill and the MRF/Transfer Station. The training is being offered to member towns. There is no DES training being offered this year other than in Concord. The training will be held at the Town & Country in Shelburne on March 9, 2011 at 6:00 pm. There will also be a buffet served at 5:00 pm. The Board approved Frank Gray and Jimmey Howland to attend the training and buffet.

One of the test wells at the Transfer Station needs to be reset. Nobis has gotten a quote from NH Boring in the amount of \$948. Linda was asked to check to see if there is someone locally that could do the work.

Norman made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Kevin seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 7:40 pm.
