

TOWN OF JEFFERSON
BOARD OF SELECTMEN
March 22, 2010

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday, March 22, 2010 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, Chairman, and Norman Brown members comprising a quorum of the Board.

Others Present: Linda Cushman, Assistant, and Kate Savage, Treasurer Paul Couture, Road Agent, Mike Hatfield

Kevin Meehan opened the meeting at 7:05 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway report was reviewed. Kate Savage was in to pick the warrants and sign checks.

An intent to cut for Jeff Young was signed. Mike Hatfield was told that the intent would be for the 2010 season.

A current use application from the Archaeological Conservancy was reviewed. The application is requesting that the land be put into the unproductive category. As unproductive is defined it means can not produce usable growth. Linda was asked to clarify this use of unproductive with the Department of Revenue before responding to the Conservancy.

Norman Brown made the motion to accept the minutes of the March 15, 2010 Selectmen meeting as written. The motion was seconded, the motion carries.

Paul Couture asked why he was not included in the retirement. Norman responded that supervisory positions were not certified as part of the retirement program at the time.

Paul said that the left from spring on the Ford had to be replaced. The dump body on the Ford should be sanded and painted this summer. Paul was asked if this maintenance had been included in the budget? No. Norman suggested to Paul to get a quote for the work, then the Board would make a decision as to what would be done.

Paul said that Burt Gilbert will finish the work on the Int'l later this spring after the plow has been removed.

Kevin told Paul that there was a plugged culvert on the Ingerson Road near the Six Gun City Shop. Paul stated that someone had damaged the culvert causing the problem. He will check it again.

There is a culvert on the Phelps Road that has to be cleaned and possible replaced. If it is replace it would be with the same size.

Kate Savage presented her request to appoint Wanda Kenison as deputy treasurer. Norman made the motion to accept the nomination. The motion was seconded and carries.

Steve Jones will be asked to attend the April 5th meeting to discuss the ambulance contract.

A letter to Jim Brady congratulating him on his school board win was signed. Also a letter to Lynn Holland thanking her for her service was signed.

The Selectmen agreed that a letter should be sent to the owner of the property across from the Applebrook asking them to pick up the tin coming off the barn. With all the wind this tin is a hazard.

Norman made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Kevin seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:10 pm.
