

TOWN OF JEFFERSON
BOARD OF SELECTMEN
March 29, 2010

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday, March 29, 2010 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, Chairman, and Bruce Hicks members comprising a quorum of the Board.

Others Present: Linda Cushman, Assistant, and Kate Savage, Treasurer

Kevin Meehan opened the meeting at 7:05 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway report was reviewed. Kate Savage was in to pick the warrants and sign checks.

Bruce Hicks made the motion to accept the minutes of the Selectmen meeting of March 22, 2010 as corrected. Kevin seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Bruce asked if the truck body to be painted was the Ford. Yes. He suggested contacting Brian Duchesne for a quote.

It was asked if Melinda Poore of Time Warner had called to make the appointment to meet with the Board regarding cable service. No, Linda Cushman said that she would contact Ms. Poore.

Linda had call Linda Kennedy of DRA regarding the current use application from the Archaeological Society. Ms. Kennedy stated that the land can not be classed as unproductive unless it truly is unproductive. A letter was sign to the Archaeological Society with this information.

The Selectmen reviewed a proposed change to the town subdivision regulations requiring "road maintenance association" and forest, wetlands and habitat restoration. Bruce stated that in principal a road association was a good idea. Kevin stated that he felt that the way the suggestion was written that it was to assertive. The actual wording should be done with the developers legal council.

As for the restoration language, the Selectmen believe that it is going overboard. It was felt that if this language was accepted that the Planning Board would have to establish a "site plan review" policy.

There was an application for assistance for rent reviewed. The Board approved the application for assistance in the amount of \$400.

Bruce made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Kevin seconded the motion. The motion carries.
