

TOWN OF JEFFERSON  
BOARD OF SELECTMEN  
April 5, 2010

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday, April 5, 2010 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, Chairman, Bruce Hicks, and Norman Brown members comprising a quorum of the Board.

Others Present: Linda Cushman, Assistant, and Kate Savage, Treasurer Paul Couture, Road Agent, Larry Wells, Gordon Rebello

Kevin Meehan opened the meeting at 7:05 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway report was reviewed. Kate Savage was in to pick the warrants and sign checks.

Bruce Hicks made the motion to accept the minutes of the Selectmen meeting of March 29, 2010 as written. Norman seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Steve Jones of Lancaster Ambulance had to reschedule this appointment , he will be in on April 12<sup>th</sup>.

Bruce reported that he had talked to Brian Duchesne regarding the painting of the Ford body. Brian will paint the body for \$100 plus cost of materials. Sand blasting is not done anymore, there is something in the paint to prevent rusting.

It was asked if the Town would continue hauling the cardboard container from Santa's Village if the Village rents the container? The Board approves the arrangements.

A credit application was signed to establish an account with Merriam Graves.

Paul stated that they would be cleaning up the brush on the roadsides this week.

Larry Wells brought in the time for the Forest Warden training that has been completed. He stated that he picked up the rakes that he had submitted the invoice for last week.

Norman Brown reported that there were 17 applicants for the WMRSD Superintendent position. Out of the 17 applicants 5 were selected to

interview. There was one applicant that was referred to the School Board to interview. Before the Board could schedule an interview. The applicant withdrew.

The selection committee agreed that there was no other applicant that met the needs of the District. The job will be advertised again.

Linda Cushman reported that she had not received a response from Melinda Poore of Time Warner. Linda was asked to try her again.

The Planning Board had requested the appointment of Gordon Rebello as an alternate member of the Planning Board. Mr. Rebello was in to discuss his appointment with the Selectmen. The Selectmen stated that they would want someone on the Planning Board that did not have a personal agenda. Mr. Rebello states that he would have no issues applying the regulations as written. The Selectmen approved the appointment. Mr. Rebello was told that he would have to come into the Town Clerk to be sworn in.

Bruce asked that the assessors be asked if there was information enough in sales to support using neighborhood values in the update.

Kevin stated the the Delegation would be meeting in Concord in the next few days to discuss salaries of county employees. The question has arose as to whether it was appropriate to discuss county business out of the area at an unpublished meeting.

Bruce made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Norman seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm.
