

TOWN OF JEFFERSON
BOARD OF SELECTMEN
April 12, 2010

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday, April 12, 2010 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, Chairman, Bruce Hicks, and Norman Brown members comprising a quorum of the Board.

Others Present: Linda Cushman, Assistant, and Kate Savage, Treasurer
Randy Flynn & Steve Jones, Lancaster Ambulance

Kevin Meehan opened the meeting at 7:00 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway report was reviewed. Kate Savage was in to pick the warrants and sign checks.

Norman Brown made the motion to accept the minutes of the Selectmen meeting of April 5, 2010 as written. Bruce Hicks seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Randy Flynn stated that last year Jefferson paid \$16,000 for ambulance service. There were 75 EMS calls and 6 fire calls. Lancaster ended the year with \$3557.00 that was uncollected. Steve Jones explained that NH Medicaid is not easy to collect. A person on medicaid has to keep their coverage up to date. Randy stated that they were comfortable with the payment from Jefferson in the amount of \$16,000. Lancaster will stay on top of the billings to try to keep from have as much outstanding balances.

A letter from Helen Owens was reviewed by the Selectmen. Ms. Owens was stating that she was was unsatisfied with the maintenance of the Valley Road. A letter will be prepared in response to Ms. Owens concerns.

Linda Cushman reported that due to medical issues the Board of Adjustment secretary will be temporarily unavailable. Linda told the BOA chairman that she would assist the BOA for the time being.

David Payeur of Isaacson Steel said that the estimate for a stamped set of plans for the bridge would be about \$2200. The Selectmen approved the cost.

Melinda Poore of Time Warner said that she would be able to meet with the Town on May 5.

An issue regarding repayment of a court order was discussed. The Board agreed that if good faith repayment was made that consideration of reducing the civil penalties was possible.

Norman made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:07 pm.
