

TOWN OF JEFFERSON
BOARD OF SELECTMEN
April 19, 2010

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday, April 19, 2010 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, Chairman, Bruce Hicks, and Norman Brown members comprising a quorum of the Board.

Others Present: Linda Cushman, Assistant, and Kate Savage, Treasurer Paul Couture, Road Agent

Kevin Meehan opened the meeting at 7:00 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway report was reviewed. Kate Savage was in to pick the warrants and sign checks.

Bruce Hicks made the motion to accept the minutes of the Selectmen meeting of April 12, 2010 as written. Norman Brown seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Building permits for John Openhowski and Kyle Dube were approved and signed.

The renewal from Primex Health was signed. The increase for health insurance coverage for the period of 7-1-10 through 6-30-11 is 14.89%.

Bruce told Paul Couture that Abigail Circle could stand to be graded. He was out there today. He asked if some fill was needed. Paul stated that some of the issue is because of someone using their ATV on the road.

Paul stated that he had ordered the grader tires. He did not know when they would arrive.

The Turnpike has been graded. Most of the brush has been picked up. Paul said that they would be working on cleaning up the Valley Road the going up on the Ingerson Road. Paul asked that the Selectmen check the upper end of the Ingerson Road for any new trees that may need to be removed.

The Board reviewed the inspection report of the Transfer Station. On a whole the inspection was good. Norman stated that he would be interested in using the glass. He is having a plan done for drainage

on his property and would be able to use the glass there. There is no market for glass. Linda said that she would check to see about the the concrete and compost disposal. Nobis Engineering is to call Wednesday to discuss the permit requirements.

Melody Stevens has asked to rent the Town Hall on May 15 for a dance as part of the Relay for Life. She asked if there would be a charge for the hall. The Selectmen agreed that if all the proceeds were being donated, there would be no charge for the hall. This would also apply to the function that Stacey Hicks is hosting on April 30.

Bruce made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Norman seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:10 pm.
