

TOWN OF JEFFERSON
BOARD OF SELECTMEN
April 26, 2010

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday, April 26, 2010 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, Chairman, and Norman Brown members comprising a quorum of the Board.

Others Present: Linda Cushman, Assistant, and Kate Savage, Treasurer

Kevin Meehan opened the meeting at 7:10 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway report was reviewed. Kate Savage was in to pick the warrants and sign checks.

Norman Brown made the motion to accept the minutes of the Selectmen meeting of April 19, 2010 as written. Kevin seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Current Use application submitted by Jim and Lisa Riendeau was reviewed and approved.

Norman made a motion to accept the bid and specs for the bridge from Jericho Bridge & Metals in the amount of \$8,900. Kevin seconded the motion. The motion carries.

It was suggested to ask Bruce Knox the engineer if he would draw up a plan to install the bridge so that it could be put out to bid. Linda Cushman will check into this.

Linda reported that she had spoken to DES regarding the disposal of the concrete and brick. This material can be buried as long as all the tile and cement board is removed (this material has a glue on it). The ash that is created from the burning of clean wood and brush only can be disposed of at Mt. Carberry.

Nobis Engineering was called regarding the filing a permit for the Transfer Station as the temporary permit that we have is no longer a valid permit. Brian Vincent suggested that they and the Town meet with DES to discuss the most appropriate permit required. Norman said that he would be in the Concord area on May 7th if an appointment for the afternoon could be arranged. Linda will contact Mr. Vincent letting him know.

Jim Kenison was in this past week. He stated that he would not be able to do the mowing this summer.

It was suggested to ask Mark Dubois if he was interested in the mowing.

Norman made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Kevin seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 7:50 pm.
