

TOWN OF JEFFERSON
BOARD OF SELECTMEN
May 10, 2010

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday, May 10, 2010 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, Chairman, Bruce Hicks and Norman Brown members comprising a quorum of the Board.

Others Present: Linda Cushman, Assistant, and Kate Savage, Treasurer,

Kevin Meehan opened the meeting at 7:05 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway report was reviewed. Kate Savage was in to pick the warrants and sign checks.

Bruce Hicks made the motion to accept the minutes of the Selectmen meeting of May 3, 2010 as written. Norman Brown seconded the motion. The motion carries.

David Earlywise, the 3rd and 4th grade teacher at the Jefferson School has asked if it would be acceptable to put a small box at the Hillside Cemetery. This box would hold stamps which are shared with others doing research. The school has gotten a grant that will provide computers to the school and this is part of the project. The box would be located on the stump near the gate and would not be in the way. The Selectmen approved the request.

Bruce stated that he had met with Bruce Knox to view the site for the bridge on Ingerson Road. Mr. Knox stated the he had some concerns with what kind of abutments to use.

Melinda Poore and Rodney King of Time Warner were in Wednesday to discuss additional service areas in Town. They stated that providing service to the west end of the Ingerson Road should not be an issue. They will be contacting the business office regarding providing service to the businesses. This would include Bailey Road and Meadows Road. They said that it would be two weeks before they would have some feedback. They will be looking at Crystal Ave., Jason Ave. and Abigail Circle for adding service. As well as extending service on the Turnpike Road to Panaroma Drive.

Norman said that he met with Brian Vincent of Nobis Engineering and Mr. Wheeler of DES. It was determined that a permit by notification

will be allowed. There needs to be a map showing the location of the buildings and containers that are on site. Nobis will make a site visit to determine this. As there will be no need to show contours there will be no need to have a new survey done. They should be able to use the map that was prepared for dump closure. Provan and Lorber may have to give permission to use the maps that they prepared.

A legal issue and personnel issue was discussed.

Linda Cushman reported the the Dept of Labor seminar she attended.

Linda said that she would be attending a meeting Thursday in Concord with Sharon Gauthier of AVRRDD regarding funding of the purposed gas line to the Fraser Mill.

Bruce made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Norman seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 7:55 pm.
