

TOWN OF JEFFERSON
BOARD OF SELECTMEN
May 24, 2010

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday, May 24, 2010 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, Chairman, Bruce Hicks and Norman Brown members comprising a quorum of the Board.

Others Present: Linda Cushman, Assistant, and Kate Savage, Treasurer, Paul Couture, Road Agent, Butch Bronson

Kevin Meehan opened the meeting at 7:10 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway report was reviewed. Kate Savage was in to pick the warrants and sign checks.

Luc Couture brought in a copy of a bill that he was going to present to the Athletic Association for supplies and work that he had done for the Association on the ball field. Luc wanted to go over the bill with the Selectmen before he presented it for payment.

Bruce Hicks made a motion to accept the minutes of the May 17th meeting as written. Norman Brown seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Paul Couture stated that he needed to order cutting edges for the grader. He would like to get the carbide edges as they should last longer than the regular cutting edges. Paul was told to get a price quote and report back to the Board.

Kevin asked Paul if he had done the clean up work on Hyfield Lane. The ditches need to be cleaned up and seeded. Paul said that he had some more work to do then he would do the clean up and seeding.

Paul was asked if he still plans on retiring as he had told the Board previously? Bruce stated that the Selectmen would like to know as they would like to be able to have someone hired so to work with him for a couple of months. Paul said yes.

Bruce made a motion to accept Paul Couture's retirement effective October 1, 2010. Norman seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Butch Bronson was in to discuss the removal of a culvert on the Stag Hollow. Mr. Bronson stated that several years ago the Town removed

the culvert above his house. Mr. Bronson said that Paul Couture had told him if the culvert needed to be put back he would do it. The Selectmen said that they would talk to Paul to see what could be done.

Abatements for Rene Lalumiere and Charles Manuel were reviewed and approved.

Norman made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:10 pm.
