The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday, June 7, 2010 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, Chairman, and Norman Brown members comprising a quorum of the Board. Bruce Hicks on vacation.

Kevin Meehan opened the meeting at 7:05 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway report was reviewed. Kate Savage was in to pick the warrants and sign checks.

A building permit was approved for the construction of a cell tower on property owned by Albert Maykut.

Both the broadband and cell towers have prior BOA approvals.

Attorney Stephen Samaha has asked for a letter stating that Santa's Village has all necessary building permits and is in full compliance of any Town ordinances. A letter was drafted and signed.

has been notified of the damage.

Kevin stated that he had check Hyfield Lane. He asked if there had been any comments on the work that was done. The only comment was that the road looked good.

Mike Gray had asked about purchasing two tons of chloride from the Town. Paul couture says that there is enough chloride to sell two tons. It was agreed that if there is enough chloride Mike could purchase two tons at the Town's cost.
