

TOWN OF JEFFERSON
BOARD OF SELECTMEN
July 26, 2010

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday, July 26, 2010 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Bruce Hicks, and Norman Brown, members comprising a quorum of the Board.

Others Present: Linda Cushman, Assistant, and Kate Savage, Treasurer Paul Couture, Road Agent, Mary Gross, Tax Collector

Bruce Hicks opened the meeting at 7:05 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway report was reviewed. Kate Savage was in to pick the warrants and sign checks.

Norman Brown made the motion to accept the minutes of the July 12, 2010 meeting as written. Bruce Hicks seconded the motion. The motion carries.

An intent to cut for Robert McCreedy was signed.

Paul Couture reported that he would install the culvert on Starr King road this week. He will check the location of the water line.

Paul will check the Ingerson Road to see what can be done at the Doan property.

Norman said that the fuel tank is no longer available that he had seen. Paul will check on purchasing a new tank.

Paul reported that Jeff Heath had started mowing of the roadsides. Chick Couture would mow the field behind the garage for \$200. The Selectmen approved the mowing behind the garage.

Tim or Terry Kenison will mow the roadsides that Tim mowed last year.

An amendment for Primex Health was reviewed and signed. There will be no dependent coverage for the period of 7/1/10 through 6/30/2011.

Linda reported that the DOT foreman Lloyd Ingerson had called. DOT is willing to provide the equipment and manpower to shim the Stag Hollow Road if the Town purchases the asphalt. Paul stated that the road was last shimmed in 1996 and the State did the entire job then. Bruce said that he will contact the DOT District 1 Engineer to discuss this matter.

Mary Gross presented the Selectmen a list of properties that have unpaid taxes for the 2007 tax year. These properties may be up for deeding 7/31/10. August 4, 2010 is the deeding date.

The outstanding taxes for the 09 year is approximately \$73,000.

The MS-5 as prepared by Corrette and Associates was reviewed and signed for submitting to Concord.

A pistol permit for Robert Keene was signed, as was a cemetery deed.

Linda reviewed with the Board some of the issues that the AVRRDD will be addressing at the 7/27 meeting that the Selectmen have been invited to attend. The issue of funding the proposed gasline to the paper mill site will be discussed.

Norman made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:13 pm.
